

“MAMLE Principal of the Year Award”

Who is eligible to receive the award?

This award may be presented to any full-time building principal that serves middle level students between 10-14 years of age.

Who can nominate?

Though nominations will typically come from the Association membership, any individual may nominate someone for this award. The principal’s superintendent must also recommend him or her for this award.

What are the criteria?

The award should be presented to a principal that has demonstrated outstanding performance in the following areas:

1. Contributions to the middle level program in his/her school and/or district
2. Effectiveness as an advocate for middle level education
3. Innovative projects or programs implemented
4. Work with professional organizations and/or associations.

What are the application requirements?

The application consists of the following items:

- **NOMINATION DATA SHEET** (see below).
- **WRITTEN NARRATIVE** (not to exceed two typed pages written by the principal and/or nominator describing his or her strengths and addressing the above criteria).
- **TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION** from colleagues or parents.
- **All items must be submitted together** and returned no later than **December 3** to:
